Explain the National Day of Catalonia to someone who has no idea what it's about.

- The National Day of Catalonia, known as La Diada, is celebrated on September 11.
- It commemorates the defense of Barcelona in 1714 during the War of the Spanish Succession.
- The day recognizes the loss of Catalan institutions.
- It pays tribute to the martyrs and heroes who sacrificed their lives for the city's defense.
- Celebrations include: Floral tributes, Concerts, Cultural festivities, Parades, Traditional performances

The main event takes place at Parc de la Ciutadella, featuring musical performances hosted by the Government of Catalonia.
