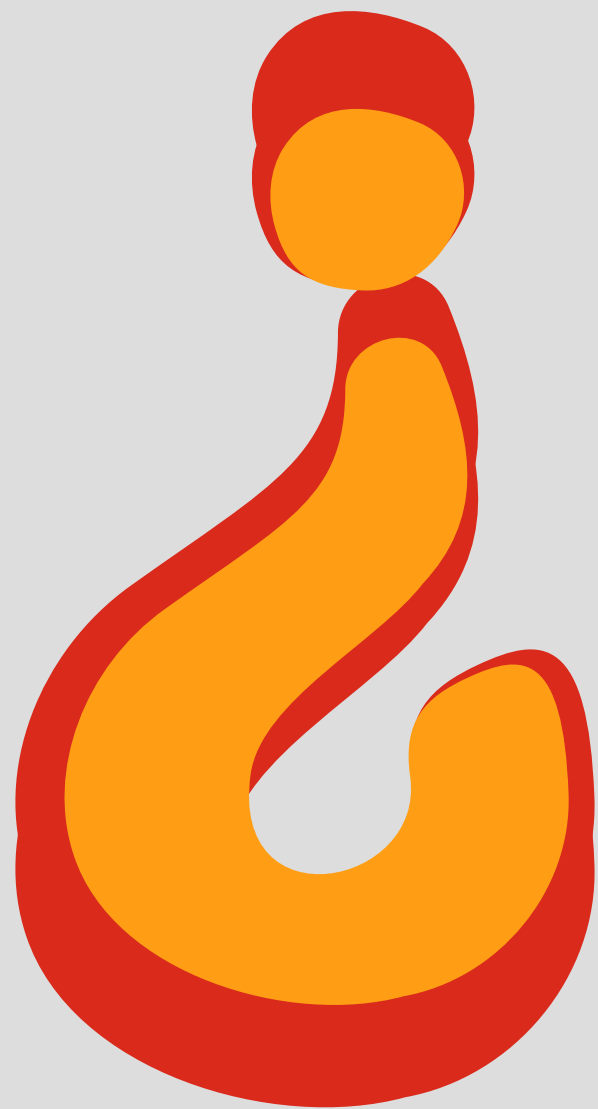


SPANISH PUNCTUATION



Signos De Interrogación

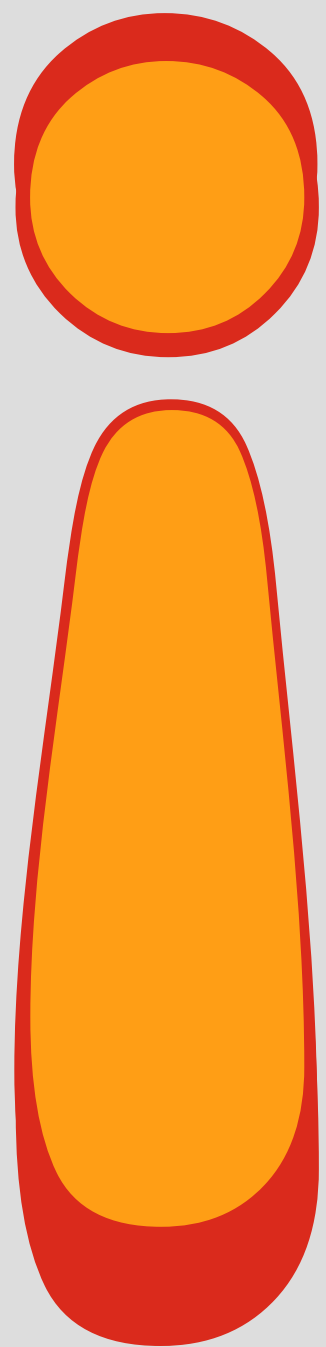


In Spanish, question marks are used to indicate the beginning and end of a question. You need to use both the opening sign (¿) and the closing sign (?) if you want to write a question. For example:

¿Dónde está tu coche?
(Where's your car?)



Signos De Exclamación



It is the same case for exclamation marks. There needs to be the opener (¡) and closer (!). For example:

¡Estoy tan emocionada!
(I am so excited!)
